#### II. ACADEMIC DETAILS

I. Objectives & Goals set by the Campus

a. Introduction of the Campus

#### Introduction

As per the recommendation of the Sanskrit Commission (1956-57) the Government of India established the Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan on 15th October 1970 as an autonomous body, for the development along with the dissemination of Sanskrit and the implementation of the Central Government's policies and programs regarding Sanskrit. Considering its multifarious importance in May 2002 the Ministry of Human Resource and Development, Government of India, has declared it a Multi Campuses Deemed University. At present total 12 campuses of this deemed university are working in different states of India among which, from the session 2002-2003, the Bhopal campus is being run in the capital city of Madhya Pradesh, Bhopal.

As the Central Sanskrit Universities Act, 2020, the Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan, New Delhi, along with its campuses as specified in the First Schedule, shall be established as a body corporate under this Act by the name of "the Central Sanskrit University", which shall have its headquarters in New Delhi.

In Bhopal Campus, six departments are running as Sahitya, Vyakaran, Jyotish, Jain Darshan, and Education with the Modern Subjects Department. The courses offered include Prak-shastri, Shastri, Acharya, Shiksha-shastri (B.Ed.), Shiksha Acharya (M.Ed.), a separate certificate course in Jyotish (3 months), Diploma in Vastushastra and Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.) in different branches of Sanskrit knowledge. For the training of the physical education a modern gymnasium along with play ground is provided to the students. Some Other focal points are as following -

- The **Mukta Swadhyay Peeth** is working in the campus for providing Sanskrit education to the people who want to learn Sanskrit.
- The campus Vararuchi Granthagara (Central Library) maintains a rich collection of many references, journals, books, other magazines, and news papers.
- The campus possesses well equipped Computer, Jyotish, Language and Psychology laboratories for the advance studies in Sanskrit.
- The well maintained open air theatre is built in the campus premises which can accommodate

- 300 people at a time.
- Bhopal Campus runs the unique Natyashastra Anusandhan Kendra which works on the theatrical presentation of the Sanskrit plays and dramas. It records and prepares the audio CDs of the Sanskrit songs and slokas.
- The Bhopal Campus publishes two ISSN journals namely Rashtri and Shastra Mimansa. The yearly departmental publications are also there in all the departments of the campus.
- From the session 2016-17 the NSS program has also been introduced in the campus. The essential process for the same has been started.

Thus, this Campus is striving hard to achieve the decided goals for the development of the Sanskrit Education.

#### Vision

- To develop Central Sanskrit University, Bhopal Campus as a most efficient teaching-learning institution with Sanskrit Learning Culture in central India.
- To highlight the contributions of the Sanskrit Scholars of Central India like Vatsraja, Vararuchi, Kavi Bhaskar etc.
- To promote the teachings of Natyashastra through Natyashastra-Anusandhan Kendra in Bhopal, as Bhopal is one of the prominent centers of modern theatre (Rangmanch).
- To make the common people aware of the great importance of Vastushastra.

#### Mission

- All-round development of all the branches of Sanskrit learning and availability of Sanskrit resources through modern systems.
- Upliftment of linguistic diversity and cultural plurality while arranging for teaching and research in Sanskrit, Pali and Prakrit in the context of their mutual cultural inter-relationship.
- Preservation and upliftment of the philosophical and scientific elements in the knowledge systems of these languages and ensuring their availability through the equipments of information and communication technology while establishing the relationship of these knowledge systems with cultural legacy.

#### b. Objectives and Background:

#### **Objectives**

As per the Memorandum of Association, the major objectives of the Central Sanskrit University, Bhopal Campus are to propagate, develop and encourage Sanskrit learning and research. This also serves as Central, Administrative and Coordinating machinery for the management of all Campuses. The Government of India has formulated various schemes and programmes for the development of Sanskrit Education and Is implementing these through Central Sanskrit University-

- To cultivate all branches of Sanskrit learning and making Sanskrit resources available through Modem Technologies.
- To undertake, aid, promotes, and co-ordinate research in all branches of Sanskrit learning including teachers' training and Manuscriptology.
- To confer degrees, grant diplomas and certificates to persons who have satisfactorily completed the approved courses.
- To Institute and award visitorships, fellowships, scholarships, stipends etc., in accordance

with the rules of the Sansthan from time to time.

 To produce skilled human-power with complete background of Sanskrit and to conduct research and comparative studies in Science with reference to Sanskrit as per Vision, Mission and Objectives defined by the Sansthan.

#### Background

The Bhopal Campus of the Central Sanskrit University ((Erstwhile Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan, Deemed to be University) was established in the year 2002, in Bhopal, the capital of Madhya Pradesh. The Campus was Inaugurated by the then Honourable Governor of Madhya Pradesh, Shri Bhai Mahavir on 16<sup>th</sup> September 2002. The Govt. of M.P has donated ten acres of land for the growth and development of this Campus. On 19<sup>th</sup> Sep. 2005 the then Honourable Minister of HRD Govt. of India, Shri Atjun Singh laid the foundation stone for the construction of the Academic, Administrative and Central Library Blocks and an Auditorium in the Campus premises.

In the first phase of construction the main building was built and since May 20I0 all academic activities and administrative functions are being carried out from this building. In the second phase of the construction separate Hostels for Girls and Boys, Guest House, Principal Residence, Staff Quarters and the Open Air Auditorium have been built. The Central Sanskrit University, Bhopal Campus aims at the implementation of all the goals of the Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi at the Regional Level as well as at Central India Level.
