We find that the current GeM portal configuration provides very little space to attach the entirety of the required documentation, as the platform often imposes strict limitations on the number of files and/ or the cumulative file size that can be uploaded under the technical bid section.  Given the volume and length of the required certificates and supporting documents, we required clear instructions to ensure compliance. We request that you immediately clarify the preferred method for submitting this
